

The Monument Manor Neighborhood Association

Monument Manor covers two square miles, 260 parcels, 217 owners, 194 developed properties, and eight miles of well-maintained dirt roads. It is a safe neighborhood with beautiful views, native vegetation, a place where wildlife can coexist with residents, and gorgeous dark night skies. It is a place where residents proactively work together to support a true sense of community.

Formed in the 1960s, the Monument Neighborhood Association's (MMNA) mission is to maintain and improve neighborhood roads, and promote community, and a high quality of life.

MMNA Goals and Objectives

1. A high level of membership and participation is achieved.

- Develop and apply new strategies to increase membership and funding.

2. MMNA roads continue to be maintained and necessary repairs and improvements are completed in a timely manner. (Monument Manor roads are NOT maintained by San Bernardino County).

- Make improvements to manage drainage to reduce erosion.
- Manage and remove sand build-ups and address storm damage repairs in a timely manner.
- Erect and maintain needed signage.
- Provide, maintain, and replace mailbox structures as needed.

3. Promote a well maintained and protected neighborhood through active resident involvement.

- Inform residents of issues that may impact the community, including county meetings that address light pollution, noise, short-term rentals, off-highway vehicle use, and protection of desert vegetation.
- Provide information on property management, covering topics such as how rodenticides impact wildlife, identifying and eliminating invasive plants, and using fencing and landscaping techniques to maintain natural habitats.

4. A sense of community is fostered through social interaction.

- Hold annual neighborhood social events, e.g., annual potluck, holiday party.
- Hold work parties for road repair and drive projects such as seed collection and planting native plants.
- Invite specialists to provide presentations that benefit the community.

5. MMNA is a well-managed organization with an effective board and engaged membership.

- Recruit board members with a wide range of talents matched to the needs of the organization.
- Implement processes for efficient operations of the organization.
- Establish committees as needed that operate efficiently with a clear purpose.
